If you are experiencing homelessness and need services, please contact the following Coordinated Entry Access Points based on your location. The Coordinated Entry Access Point will then conduct an assessment and refer you to the appropriate program or service as openings become available.

#### **City of Atlanta**

Monday-Friday 6 am – 4 pm

Ask the front desk for a housing assessment. Assessments are provided on a first-come, first-served basis. This location also serves as a single men's shelter, but it is the designated assessment center for families and all others seeking housing services within City of Atlanta limits. They do not accept calls about housing assessments- you must go in person. **Plan to arrive as early as possible.**

#### **City of Atlanta Coordinated Entry Mobile Access Points**
